# NAGALAND : JEE - 2008

## GUIDE-LINES FOR SELECTION TO TECHNICAL/MBBS & ALLIED DEGREE COURSES

Please read the following guidelines carefully before filling in the application form

- 1) Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.
- 2) Selection based on false information will be ipso facto rejected.

Selection shall be through the process of a written examination, namely Joint Entrance Examination (JEE). The examination may precede declaration of results of the 10+2/equivalent examination by the various recognized Board/Universities. Selection of candidates shall be made for nomination to the various courses on the basis of **order of merit in the JEE** and other standing Orders of the Government issued from time to time by a Common Selection Board to be constituted by the Govt. The candidate shall however be required to fulfill the admission criteria prescribed by the concerned Institute to which he/she is nominated/sponsored.

### Eligibility :

1. A candidate shall be eligible to appear in the Entrance Examination provided:
  - (i) He/She is a member of any Indigenous schedule tribe of Nagaland.  
OR
  - (ii) He/She is an Indigenous Non-Local resident (Nepali/Gurkha who has settled in the erstwhile Naga Hill District prior to 31st December 1940 (1) declared vide Home Department (P&AR) NO.GAB-8/2/9/73 as published in the Nagaland Gazette Part-II dated 31-12-1975.  
OR
  - (iii) His/Her father/mother is an employee of Nagaland State Government or a member of All India Services of Nagaland Cadre.  
OR
  - (iv) His/Her father/mother is a Central Govt. Employee working in Nagaland for a period of not less than 3 (three) calendar years.  
OR
  - (v) He/She is a resident in the State of Nagaland and whose father/ mother is enrolled in the Electoral Roll, within the State of Nagaland, published 5 (five) years preceding the year of application.
2.
  - (a) He/She has passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination from any Board /University recognized by the Government of India in all the subjects in **ONE** attempt and has obtained 40% marks minimum in the case of SC/ST and 55% marks in the case of the others in subjects prescribed in the JEE, viz Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology.
  - (b) Candidates who have appeared and are awaiting the 10+2/ Equivalent Examination results are also eligible to sit for the JEE. They shall however be required to fulfill the above mentioned conditions on declaration of the 10+2 or equivalent result.
  - (c) He/She is within the age group of 17 to 22 years on the 1st March of the year of appearing the JEE.
  - (d) He/She is mentally sound to undergo the course of study.
  - (e) He/She bears a good moral character.
  - (f) A candidate shall **not** be eligible to appear in the JEE if he/she was earlier selected and nominated / sponsored by the State Government for any Technical/MBBS and Allied Course.
  - (G) A candidate who passes the 10+2/equivalent examination with Back Paper is **not** Eligible and **need not** apply.

### All intending Candidates shall:

- (a) Submit an application duly filled in the prescribed form within the time specified.
- (b) Fill the application in his/her own handwriting with name **as per HSLC / Matric admit card in capital letters** (sufficient gap should be kept between the first name, second name, third name and so on).
- (c) Attach **attested** copies of the following documents along with the application (**Xerox / Photostat copies of documents must also be attested**).
  - (i) H.S.L.C Examination Admit Card (for age proof)
  - (ii) 10+2 Admit Card.
  - (iii) 10+2 or equivalent examination Mark sheet (if results are declared)
  - (iv) 3 (three) copies of recent passport size photographs with his/her name written at the back of the photographs, one of which must be pasted on the application form.
- (d) Furnish : Whichever is applicable.
  - (i) ST and Indigenous inhabitant Certificate.
  - (ii) Non-Naga Local Indigenous inhabitant Certificate.
  - (iii) Certificate of employment from the Head of department
  - (iv) Certificate from Head of the Department specifying the year and the date of either of the parents joining service in Nagaland.
  - (v) Certificate from competent authority stating that the father/mother is enrolled in the electoral Roll within the State Nagaland.

### Conduct of Examination:

- (i) The Nagaland Board of School Education, Kohima shall conduct the Join Entrance Examination on such date (s) and place as may be decided in consultation with the Government, tentatively in **May 2007**.
- (ii) The JEE shall be conducted in the following subjects :  
(A) Physics (P), (b) Chemistry (C), (c) Mathematics (M) & (d) Biology (B)
- (iii) There shall be a single paper in each of the subjects mentioned above.  
The duration for each paper shall be 90 (ninety) minutes with full marks of 100 in each; there shall be no practical tests.
- (iv) The standard of the Examination shall be equivalent to that of 10+2 equivalent examination of various Universities and Boards in the country. However, for the general guidance of the candidate, an outline syllabi of the relevant subjects shall be made available by NBSE, on payment.
- (v) A candidate who opts for Engineering/Technology/Agricultural Engineering Degree Course shall be required to appear in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM).
- (vi) A candidate who opts for MBBS / Dental / Veterinary and other allied courses shall be required to appear in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB)
- (vii) A candidate who opts for B.Sc Agri must have obtained 45% marks in aggregate at 10+2 level.
- (viii) A Candidate who opts for Biotechnology must have obtained 45% marks in aggregate with Mathematics as a subject at 10+2 level.
- (ix) Method of selection and nomination of the candidates to Gujarat State :-  
In Gujarat State, a nominated Candidate for MBBS must have secured at least 40% marks in each of the theory papers of PCMB. In M.P Shah Medical College, a candidate has to deposit a sum of Rs. 75,000/- as security deposit till the completion of the study period and after which money is refunded provided the candidate renders at least three years service. In the event of failure to render three years service, the amount will be forfeited and go to the State of Gujarat.

Thus, the MBBS seat (s) for Gujarat will be filled up by a candidate under the following two criteria.

- (a) A candidate must have secured at least 40% in all the theory papers of PCMB.
- (b) The seat will be given to candidate(s) whose serial number comes at last in the MBBS selected Merit list.

**NOTE:** Unlike other candidates, the nominee for Gujarat MBBS will not have freedom to choose the place of study. However, if any other candidates (having illegible conditions fulfilled) volunteers to study at Gujarat, the chance shall be given to that candidate.

- (ix) A candidate who opts for both Engineering/Technology, MBBS and allied courses shall be required to appear in all the four subjects viz. Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology (PCMB). However, on declaration for the JEE he/she shall be required to exercise his/her final option for either Engineering (PCM) or MBBS & Allied (PCB) as selection for these courses shall be done separately. The options once exercised in writing shall be final & binding. Exercise of PCM or PCB option must be submitted to the Director **within 3(three) days after publication of written results of JEE.**
- (x) The NBSE shall declare the result of the JEE on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the candidates, in order of merit.
- (xi) In the event of two or more candidates securing same aggregate marks, the inter-se-merit shall be determined on the basis of the following:
  - A. For Engineering:
    - Higher marks obtained in Mathematics in the Entrance Examination.
    - Higher marks obtained in Physics in the Entrance Examination.
    - Higher marks in Chemistry in the entrance Examination.
    - Older age.
  - B. For Medical and Allied Courses:
    - Higher marks obtained in Biology in the Entrance Examination.
    - Higher marks obtained in Chemistry in the entrance Examination.
    - Higher marks obtained in Physics in the entrance Examination
    - Older age.
- (xii) **Re-evaluation of answer script is not permissible.**
- (xiii) PCM Candidates are eligible to join the B. Sc. Agriculture SASARD at Medziphema.

### **Procedure for Selection.**

- (i) The selection of candidates to be nominated/sponsored against the available seats shall be made by the COMMON SELECTION BOARD on the basis of merit of his/her performance in the JEE and to other standing Orders of the Government issued from time to time regarding reservation etc. The candidate shall however be required to fulfill the admission criteria prescribed by the concerned Institution to which he/she is nominated/sponsored.
- (ii) Candidates whose 10+2 result are not yet declared will be required to submit true copies of his/her mark-sheet duly attested by the competent authority immediately after declaration of the Board / University result but not later than 5(five) days before the meeting of the Common Selection Board failing which he/she forfeits his/her seat.
- (iii) A selected candidate shall be required to produce his/her JEE Admit Card and Mark sheet of 10+2 or equivalent examination in ORIGINAL before issue of the Nomination letter.

## **General Information:**

- (i) Overwriting should be avoided.
- (ii) Incomplete application will be summarily rejected.
- (iii) For last date of submission, see the advertisement.
- (iv) The Directorate shall not be responsible for any loss in transit of any material sent by post.
- (v) For any additional information required, the Directorate of Information Technology & Technical Education may be contacted.
- (vi) Selection of places of study shall be allowed in respect of the following branches of study for which Notices shall be given from time to time.  
MBBS, BDS, B.Sc. Nursing, BHMS, B. Pharm/Pharmacy.
- (vii) The allotment of place to the selected candidates for Engineering Degree course will be done by the Directorate office, basing on the eligibility criteria for admission as laid down by the concerned States.
- (viii) The Central Govt Seats for MBBS/BDS course and the NEC seats for B.V.Sc Course are received in different timing, thereby nomination of candidates for B.V. Sc. Course will be considered basing on 1st option/preference given by the candidate in order of merit of JEE result. Candidates may submit their option to the Directorate after one week from the date of publication of JEE result.
- (ix) Canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and may lead to disqualification of the candidate concerned.
- (x) Applicants MUST NOT indicate preferences in those branches of studies for which they are not interested. Once preferences are indicated by the applicants, and if selected against any of the preferences, the candidates must accept the nominations. If not, the candidates will be debarred from sitting in the JEE from the following year. This step has been necessitated to discourage the uninterested students from spoiling the chance of other candidates who may like to pursue other branches of study
